The Board of Commissioners of McCone County, Montana, met in regular session with Lonny Jensen, Ty Taylor, and Alan Stempel present. Presiding Officer Lonny Jensen called the meeting to order. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Commissioner Taylor moved to approve the agenda. Commissioner Stempel seconded the motion and the motion passed 3-0. **(A copy of the agenda is on file in the Commissioners' files.)**

Cary Phillips, South Road Foreman, met with the Board to discuss winter weather preparation, and Road Department issues. The Board approved the purchase of road grader tires for approximately \$5,000.

The Board reviewed the Type I Zoning requirements.

Jeanne Massar, Frank Wright, and Greg Nagel met with the Board to provide an update on requesting Type 1 zoning on the Mount Antelope area.

The November 17, 2025 minutes were approved as read.

Commissioner Stempel reported on the Eastern Montana Community Mental Health Center Board meeting he attended, in Miles City, on November 19, 2025.

The Board attended the LEPC meeting at noon.

The meeting was opened to public participation at 1:00 p.m.

The Board reviewed and approved the Grant Agreement with MDOT, Aeronautics Division, for the Circle Town/County Airport improvement project. **(A copy of the agreement is on file in the Commissioners' files.)**

Dan Curtiss, North Road Foreman met with the Board, by phone to discuss Road Department issues, and recommending purchasing a Compact Tracked Loader from Butler Ag Equipment.

The Board reviewed and approved the Butler Ag Equipment Sales Agreement for a new Compact Tracked Loader for \$78,201.64 for the North Road Shop. **(A copy of the agreement is on file in the Commissioners' files.)**

The Board tabled the decision for demolition of the Fairgrounds buildings due to lack of bids submitted.

Kerry Eissinger, Deputy Clerk and Recorder, met with the Board to discuss Clerk and Recorder issues.

The Board tabled the Cash Reconciliation and Investment Report for October 2025.

Paul Skyberg, Sheriff, and Joe Juliano, Under Sheriff, met with the Board to discuss law Enforcement issues.

Kim Bradley, Redwater Valley Ambulance Service President, Katie Bertolino, RVAS member, Paul Skyberg, Sheriff, and Joe Juliano, Under Sheriff, met with the Board to discuss parking at the Vetjasa Building, snow removal, and ambulance issues.
