Cary Phillips, South Road Foreman, met with the Board to discuss potentially moving the Quonset buildings from the Fairgrounds to the County yard, snow removal, vehicle repairs, and the new snow plow for the pickup. The Board approved vehicle repairs for a road grader for approximately \$2,000.

Kandi Holland, Senior Center Administrator, met with the Board to discuss parking, and congregate meals.

Chad Bieber, Planning Board Chairman, met with the Board to discuss county wide zoning. The Board will email Stahly Engineering to request assistance with applying for a CDBG grant to complete zoning regulations.

Jeanne Massar, and Greg Nagel, met with the Board to provide an update on requesting Type 1 zoning on the Mount Antelope area.

Sherry Kluth, Clerk and Recorder, met with the Board to discuss county issues.

The Board of Commissioners of McCone County, Montana, met in regular session with Lonny Jensen, Ty Taylor, and Alan Stempel present. Presiding Officer Lonny Jensen called the meeting to order. The pledge of allegiance was recited. Commissioner Taylor moved to amend the agenda to add the KLJ Reimbursement Request #3 for the Circle Town/County Airport Improvement Project, a Tax Adjustment, and the Cash Reconciliation Reports for September and October, 2025 from the Treasurer's office. The December 1, 2025 minutes were approved as amended.

Christine Weider, Weider Consulting, met with the Board, by phone, to discuss a possible extension of the MCHC Improvement Project timeline.

The Board discussed their next steps to research and develop Type I zoning for the Mount Antelope area.

The Board reviewed the CDBG Draw Request #7 for the MCHC Improvement Project. Commissioner Taylor moved to approve the request. Commissioner Stempel seconded the motion and the motion passed 3-0. **(A copy of Draw Request #7 is on file in the Commissioners' files.)**

The Board tabled the decision to appoint a new member to the Missouri River Board.

The Board reviewed the KLJ Reimbursement Request #3 for the Circle Town/County Airport Improvement Project. Commissioner Taylor moved to approve the request. Commissioner Stempel seconded the motion and the motion passed 3-0. **(A copy of the request is on file in the Commissioners' files.)**

The Board reviewed Voucher # 1019. Commissioner Stempel moved to approve the voucher. Commissioner Taylor seconded the motion and the motion passed 3-0. **(A copy of the voucher is on file in the Commissioners' files.)**

Jeannie Rosseland, Director Dry Redwater Rural Water Authority Director, met with the Board to discuss ARPA funds and current DRWA plans.

Nita Crockett, Treasurer, met with the Board to present the updated Cash Reconciliation and Investment Reports for September and October 2025. Commissioner Stempel moved to approve the report and Commissioner Taylor seconded. The motion passed 3-0. The Board reviewed a Tax Adjustment. Commissioner Stempel moved to approve Tax Adjustment #0232 for \$1,564.64, and Commissioner Taylor seconded. The motion passed 3-0 **(Copies of the reports and Tax Adjustment are on file in the Commissioners' files.)**
